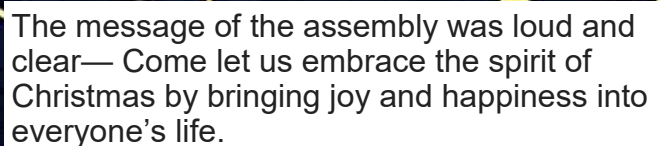
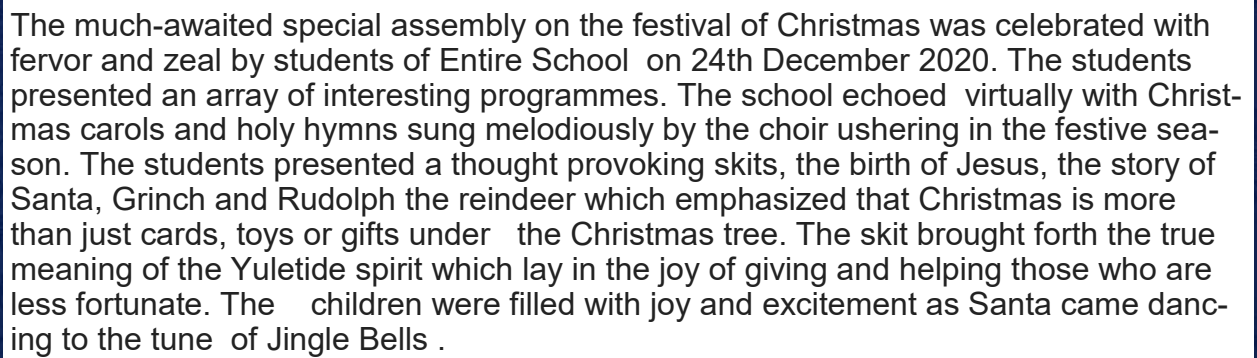
Christmas Day Celebration

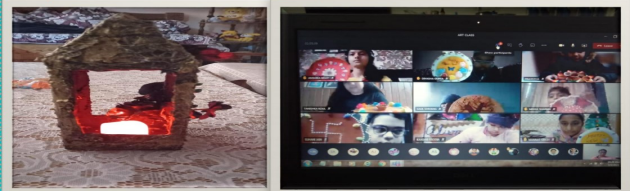

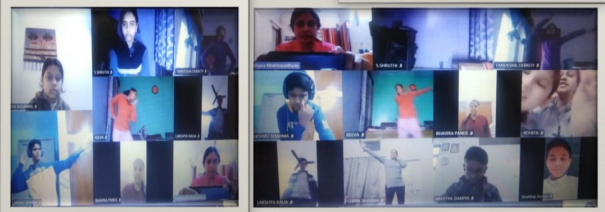
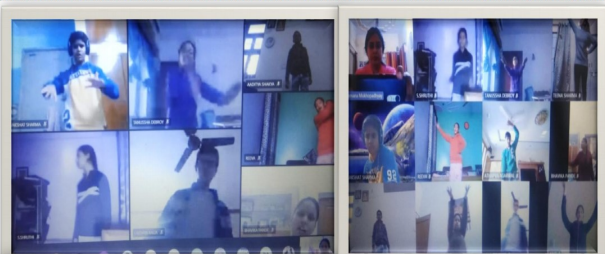
The co-curricular activities held in our school help students to showcase, improve and learn more about their talents and interest.



DANCE

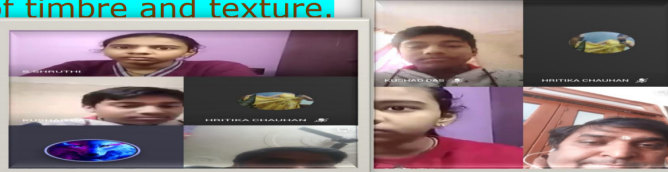
Dancing is surely the most basic and relevant of all forms of expression. "Nothing else can so effectively give outward form to an inner experience"- Lyall Watson

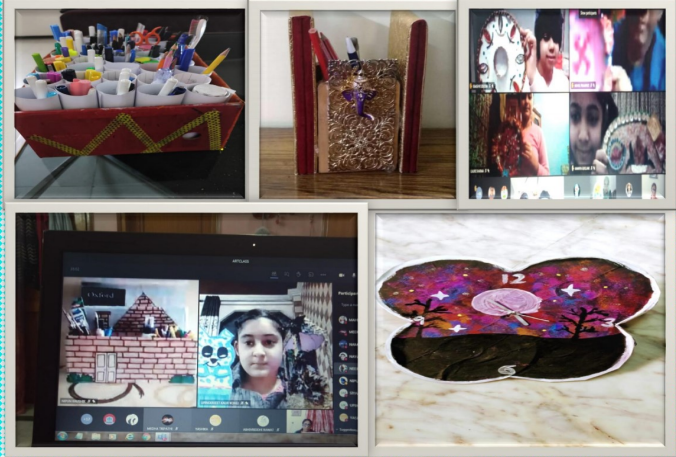

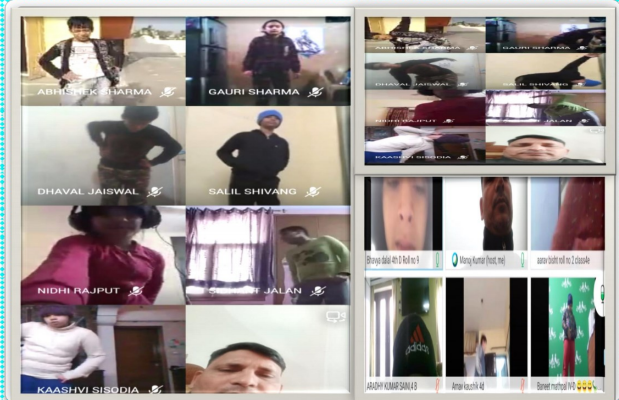
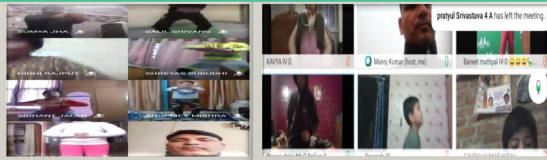
Art and craft

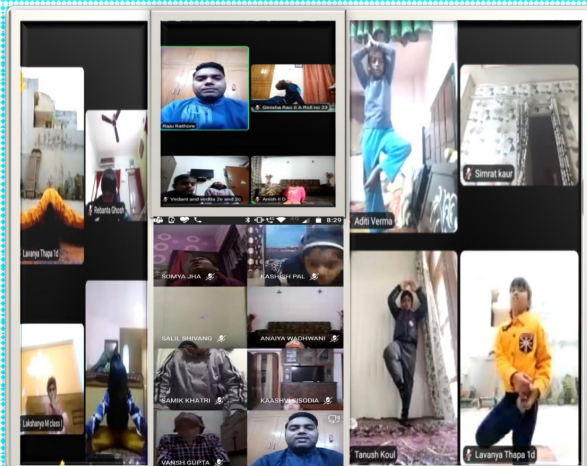
PHYSICAL EDUCATION

K. Bagrodia Public School organized Town Hall Spiritual Series on December 21st, 2020. The speaker of the session was **Mrs Preetima Khandelwal**—Master Trainer DoE, NCERT, SCERT. The session was based on the theme – “**Mindfulness—How to remain happy.**” The session began with the Prayer & welcome of the Speaker.

Mrs Preetima Khandelwal started the session with a Meditation activity highlighting **one's concentration to recognize the surrounding voice along with your inner voice.** She further highlighted that we need to be grateful & to develop mindful gratitude. She conducted an activity showing the **journey of an Apple from the farmer's field to one's plate.** This activity highlighted the importance of gratitude in our journey of life. The speaker spoke about the **Three Tudes—Gratitude, Attitude & Aptitude** and if we take care of these three it multiplies to gain one's magnitude & Altitude. We should often say Thank you & be grateful as it makes us happy. We should develop resilience to combat the difficult situations. She narrated the famous quotes of **Charlie Chaplin** – “**Nothing is permanent in this world, not even our troubles**”, “**The most wasted Day of ours is the Day we didn't smile**”, “**Enjoy-Whatever you have with you**”.

She also discussed about the word **POWER—as it simply expands into Problem, Option, Weigh the Option, Elect & Response.** She gave different words to the children like Flower, Moon & instructed them to write the words they can think & associate with these words. This activity of Word Association captured the attention of the students in the audience and demonstrated an easy way to enhance our Mindfulness. She also conducted the activity on checking one's heartbeat & Pulse rate as a part of Mindfulness. Mrs Preetima Khandelwal highlighted the significance of Music in bringing the essence of Mindfulness & being happy. She concluded her session with her **two self-composed, very melodious & inspiring songs.** The lyrics of the songs are—“**Ek Nayee Soch Hai, Sab Bada lo Kadam**” & “**Lakshay par Nigaah Ho**”. She encouraged the attendees to sing along with her and absorb the essence of the song in our daily lives. The Principal of the School gave away the Vote of Thanks. She appreciated the activities conducted to improve one's concentration.
