Class II: Making an orange paper Hat and writing a short slogan about Unity on it

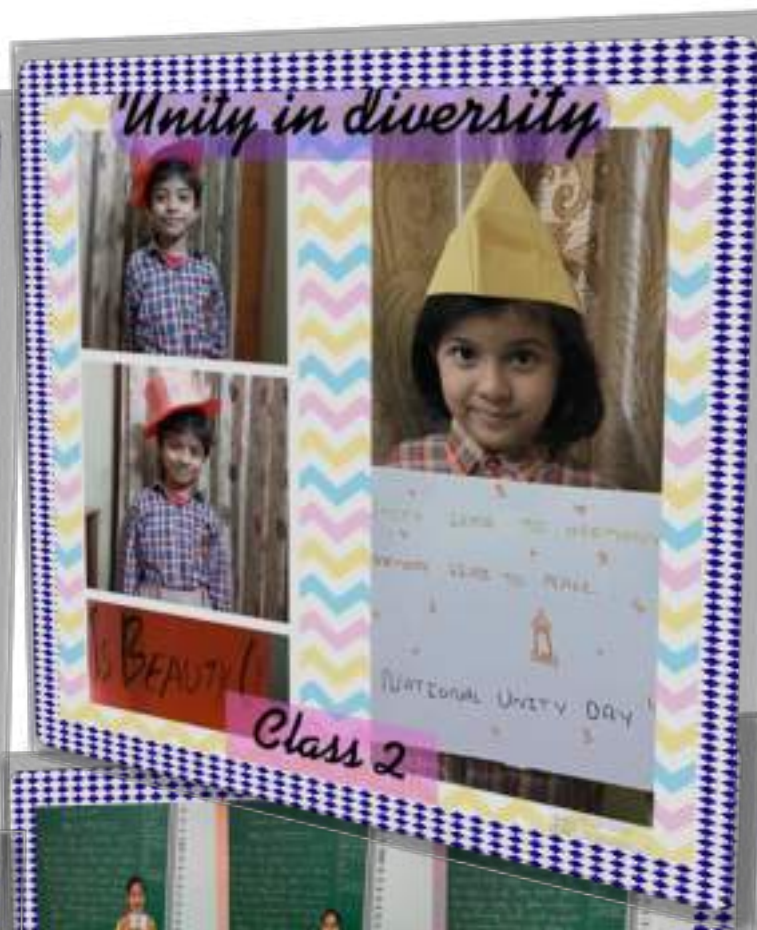
Class III and IV: Poem Recitation on Unity Day

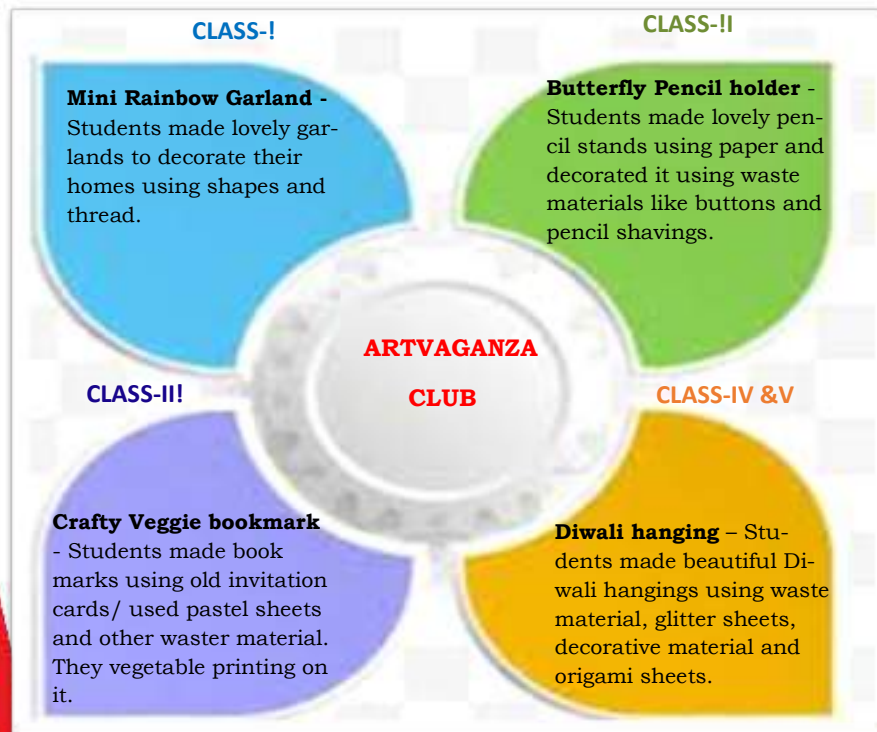

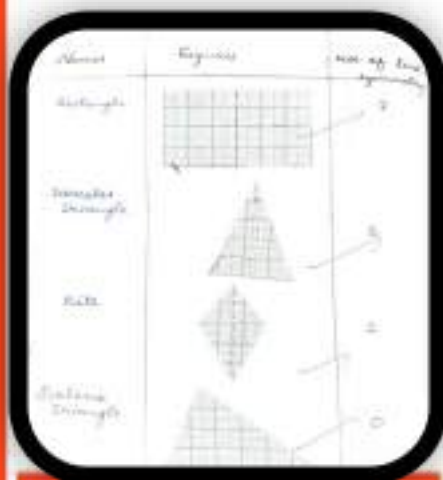
