




Swachh Bharat Mission

We should learn from these birds that one's happiness should not be dampened by another. What's the use of happiness-teaching books if one does not learn to live in the moment?



Le français est aussi la deuxième langue étrangère la plus enseignée au monde après l'anglais, et sur tous les continents. La Francophonie regroupe 68 États et gouvernements. La France dispose enfin du plus grand réseau d'établissements culturels à l'étranger où sont dispensés des cours de français à plus de 750 000 personnes.

Le français est souvent considéré comme la langue de la culture. Tout cours de français s'accompagne d'un voyage culturel dans le monde de la mode, de la gastronomie, des arts, de l'architecture et de la science.
